

Spotlight on attendance

You may remember in last week's newsletter we shared details with you about term-time absences and the fines parents are likely to receive if they do choose to take their child out of school during term time. These fines are paid to the local authority and school do not receive any of the money. If the fine is not paid the local authority will take the case to court and parents may end up being fined up to £1000 as well as court costs.

We are duty bound to refer all absences of this nature to the local authority. We are also duty bound to share with parents the outcomes of any court cases for term-time absences. We have received notification this week that a parent who took their child on holiday in last year and did not pay the subsequent fine now has a total fine of £741.
