• Garden spades, trowels, gloves and any other gardening equipment (not forks)


- · Wellies or waterproof clothing that your children have outgrown

Spotlight on attendance

A big 'thank you' to all of the parents who are working with us to improve our attendance. We made some good improvements at the end of last term, but unfortunately our attendance for this week is only 91.9%. If your child has a cough or a cold, we still expect your child to be attending school. When dropping off your child, please inform a member of staff in the playground of your worries. Please be assured, staff will look after your child and will contact parents if they are concerned in anyway. Remember our handy traffic light guide to help you decide whether to send your child to school or not.

RED - **STAY AT HOME** Sickness and diarrhoea - 24 hours must have elapsed before a child can return to school from the last episode.

AMBER - SEEK ADVICE Headache, feeling sick, tummy ache. Children often feel unwell if they are anxious, so if in doubt contact the school for advice, and if appropriate a dose of liquid paracetamol or ibuprofen before school may be all they need to help them feel well enough to attend.

GREEN - COME TO SCHOOL Mild cough, cold, sore throat, feeling tired. We will always contact you if your child is ill during the school day.
